

Feng Shui Prosperity - Secrets to More Wealth with Water

In feng shui, prosperity and wealth energy can be increased by using moving water, and is considered a very powerful cure. It symbolizes nourishment, wealth and the flow of life. Water not only stimulates the mind with its soothing sound but it also has the ability to give the body energy.

It is advisable to add water cures to both the interior and exterior of your home or office. It creates a peaceful environment, the sound of flowing water over stones and rocks creates a gentle, soothing sound that emits energies relating to health, the release of negative elements, well-being and ease in breathing.

Fountains are among the most popular water cure symbols in feng shui. Prosperity can be enhanced by use of fountains or waterfalls, which provide a constant flow of energy, and if placed efficiently, will have a huge beneficial impact on any space. It is important to remember not to place it where the fire element is strongest, as it dampens the energies in that area.

Moving water connotes the increased flow of your income. The steadier and more constant the flow of water, the more money will flow into your home bringing you increased feng shui prosperity. Still bodies of water, on another hand, represent stored wealth. It also symbolizes clarity and depth of knowledge. Good examples of these are lakes, ponds, and pools, all of which help enhance the good chi in its environment.

There are a few key principles to be observed when adding a water cure to your environment.

Make sure that the size of the water cure is proportionate to your house. Too large of a body of water will overwhelm the house's energy and suck in the occupants' chi. Take note of the shape and placement of the water body. Organic shapes are better for pools and ponds in close proximity to the house. Sharp angles and edges of a square or rectangular water feature represent poison arrows, which can stimulate accidents for the residents. Shapes that have angles pointing away from the house also represent money leaving the home. Organic shapes which "hug" and surround the house are better in feng shui, prosperity energy can be gathered and stay in the house. Any still water should be clear and clean as this represents your finances and state of mind.

Another powerful symbol for a water cure are aquariums. Aquariums with fish in them represent a combination of water energy and living energy. Aquariums are usually fitted with pumps that increase the flow of energy of feng shui. Prosperity and wealth energy symbolized in these tanks, stimulates the flow of existing chi as well as attracting new chi. Aquariums with fish are said to bring good luck, good fortune, and a constant flow of wealth. The best fish for aquariums are colorful, playful fish, which stimulate flexibility and ease in dealing with various things in your life.

Water embodies the yin energy—it is calm, soothing and neutral. The best colors for this energy are blue and black. Wavy shapes and metallic hues that symbolize the flow and reflective property of water are also good representations of this energy and this element. Water is the first and the last in the Productive cycle. It starts the cycle by providing nourishment, and ends it as a product of its own creative cycle.
